Abbott's Passage Winery & Mercantile

777 Madrone Road, Glen Ellen | Open Daily 10am – 5pm

Beautiful Winery nestled between two Mountain Ranges. Bocce Ball and beautiful grounds for the entire family to enjoy.

Benziger Family Winery's Tractor Tram Tour

1883 London Ranch Rd, Glen Ellen | Open Daily 10am – 5pm

Located here in the Sonoma Valley, this family run winery was the first to apply bio-dynamic farming to winemaking. They offer a fun and educational tractor tram tour of their gorgeous vineyards and winery. Reservations required.

B.R. Cohn Winery

Located north of our hotel, B. R. Cohn offers great wines for the parents with olive oil tastings available for the whole family. Gourmet shop is available on site for picnic items. Beautiful grounds and very close proximity to our Inn make it a wonderful way to start or end your day.

Buena Vista Winery

California's first Premium Winery offers fun for the whole family. Historic buildings, a wine tool museum and great tour options.

Cline Cellars

24737 Arnold Drive/Highway 121, Sonoma | Open Daily 10am – 6pm

Located in the southern portion of the Sonoma Valley, this historic winery is fun for the whole family. They have beautiful vineyards, large open lawns and shaded picnic tables. They also have bird aviaries, a Missions of California museum, donkeys and large koi pond.

Deerfield Ranch Winery

Located in Kenwood, Deerfield Ranch Winery is known for its beautiful cave, protected marshland and its low sulfite, clean red wines. A picnic table is available on site and as well as a bocce court for guests of the winery to use.

Imagery Estate

Jacuzzi Family Vineyards

Kivelstadt Cellars

Larson Family Winery

Also located in the southern portion of the Sonoma Valley, this winery is located on an authentic rodeo ranch and has wonderful dogs that have their own wines named after them. They also have horse shoe pits and bocce ball available to keep the kids happy while the adults taste.

Matanzas Creek Winery and Lavender Fields

Located in the beautiful Bennett Valley where Merlot is King, Matanzas's Creek offers beautiful views, Lavender fields in season and wine tasting for parents. Please note that the winery is about 25 minutes away from the Fairmont Sonoma Mission Inn.

Landmark Winery

Bartholomew Park Hiking Trail

Cornerstone

23570 Hwy 121, Sonoma | Open Daily 10am – 5pm

There is something for everyone at this collection of gardens on 9 beautiful acres. This tourist center has a playground, art museum, sculpture garden, antique shops and a garden center. There are multiple wine tasting rooms and Folktable restaurant that is great for lunch.

Sonoma Plaza

270 First Street West, Sonoma

This park houses a small train museum and outside is a real train car suitable for climbing and exploring. The park has play equipment designed for kids and is fun and safe for all ages. The Plaza park is larger with more play equipment and a great duck pond.

Jack London State Historic Park

2400 London Ranch Road, Glen Ellen.

A beautiful and historic park with great hiking trails.

Maxwell Park

100 West Verano Avenue, Sonoma

This Park is close to the hotel and offers many amenities, including tennis courts, a paved jogging track, soccer & baseball fields, Skate Park, a recently remodeled playground and hiking trails.

North Sonoma Mountain Regional Park and Preserve

Sonoma Mountain Road. Beautiful views of surrounding mountaintops and terrific scenery.

Quarry Hill Botanical Gardens

12841 Sonoma Highway, Glen Ellen | Open Daily 9am – 4pm (Botanical Garden Walk)

Quarry Hill is a beautiful location with one of the largest collections of scientifically documented, wild sourced Asian plants in the Western World. Docent led tours are available with 2 weeks' notice.

Sonoma Fun Center

Miniature golf and indoor arcade; fun for the whole family! Located in the Maxwell Village Shopping center, 1.5 miles away from the Fairmont Sonoma Mission Inn.

Sonoma Mission & Barracks

114 E. Spain St, Sonoma | Open Daily 10am – 5pm

Located in the downtown plaza of Sonoma, this was the last of the California Missions built and the reason our little town exists. This historic site is beautiful, educational and fun.

Sonoma Originals

Located about 15 minutes walking distance, Sonoma Originals houses a kid friendly Kombucha & Shrubs Bar, Half Pipe, and Skate shop. Very hip and very friendly!

Train Town

Train Town has a miniature steam locomotive which takes you on a 20 minute train ride through their 10 acre landscaped park, filled with trees, animals (petting zoo), bridges, tunnels, waterfalls and historic replica structures. There's also an Iron Horse Carousel, High Iron Ferris Wheel, Dragon Train Coaster & Other Rides.

Charles M. Schulz Museum and Research Center

Children's Museum of Sonoma County
